



### Explanatory Notes

- 1 The 2010 school fees listed above (Column B) are as shown in your 2010 fee communication distributed at the end of the third term this year and are unchanged for the full year
- 2 The capital development levy as previously announced (Column C) will only be charged for the first term of 2010.
- 3 The amended capital levy shown above (Column F) will be charged from the second term in 2010. This levy will be regularly reviewed and may be adjusted as circumstances warrant.  
Parents have the option of paying the capital development levy annually at the same discount as is offered for paying school fees, on the standard termly basis together with school fees or as an upfront  
4 once off lump sum payment
- 5 The once off lump sum will fulfill all your levy obligations until the end of 2014 or until your daughter finishes grade 12. The lump sum (see Column I above) gives you a discount (Column J) to the  
estimated total levy payments to end 2014 (Column G).
- 6 The lump sum payment has been calculated on the assumption that the annual capital levy will not change until the end of 2014. This, however, cannot be guaranteed but you will exclude yourself from any
- 8 The reduced capital levy charged on Grade 12 parents will only apply to 2010. From 2011, Grade 12 parents will pay the full levy charged for other High School girls  
9 up by 20th March 2010.
- 10 For parents/guardians with more than one daughter at St Cyprians, the reduced levy (at 50%) will be based on your second daughter's capital levy scale
- 11 No levies will be charged on your third or fourth daughter
- 12 Please note that capital levies charged to Matric parents will also be spread over the first 3 terms of the year as is the case with school fees.
