ST CYPRIAN'S SCHOOL MATRICS EXCEL IN 2015 NSC (MATRIC) RESULTS

For a second year in a row, 41% of the St Cyprian's School matric class (26 of the 63 students) attained distinction aggregates, a remarkable achievement! A total of 237 subject distinctions were achieved across all subjects, with English, History, Mathematics in particular, yielding excellent results. Subjects in which St Cyprian's girls excelled, with class averages of more than 80%, included English, History, Economics, Music, Geography, Design, Dramatic Arts, Visual Arts, Mathematical Literacy and Life Orientation. The number of subject distinctions above 90% (68) was also noteworthy.

Alana Williams, the Head Girl for 2015, was the top student. She achieved 7 Distinctions, and an average of 94% overall, with her highest mark being 99% for Geography. Micaela Wanamaker achieved 8 Distinctions, scoring 98% in Mathematics and 91% in Advanced Programme Mathematics. Overall, nine students achieved 7 Distinctions, eight achieved 6 Distinctions and another eight went home with 5 Distinctions.

St Cyprian's School is proud of its academic record, having been ranked in the Western Cape Education Department's (WCED) Top Schools list for many years. The expectations of the 2015 Matrics were high, but students rose to the challenge and surpassed their own goals, said Principal Sue Redelinghuys. "The quality of our results is hugely impressive, and I am absolutely delighted for my students and teachers that their hard work has been rewarded. There is a mutual respect and understanding that education is a partnership between the teachers and students. The teachers not only set the tone but also share in the joy when the results come in. I couldn't be prouder."
